- Rules (for class, of a game, funny school rules ...)
- Letters (to friends, editors, application letter, complaints ...)
- Travel diaries (of class trip, holidays ...)
- Interpretations (of stories, diagrams, graphs, charts, literature)
- Recipes (of favourite food, cakes...)
- Application forms (curriculum vitae, letter ...)
- Entries of reading logs / viewing logs.

Language:

- Mind maps, clusters ...
- Vocabulary lists
- Assessment sheets
- Test results (pre-test evaluation, after - test comments, ...)
- Worksheets (showing your growing command of language).

Media - based work:

- Presentations (on CD, video, computer - animated, photos of exhibition ...)
- Collage
- Photo stories
- Picture stories
- Tape recordings (radio play ...)
- Self - made websites (homepage ...)
- Video sketches.
