Rules for clever lessons

- 1. At the beginning of a clever lesson take out your folder.
- 2. Have a look at the material. Decide which task you would like to take. Choose the suitable level of difficulty for you.
- 3. What is the task? Do you have to work alone, with a partner or in a group?
- 4. Work efficiently and quietly for around 30 minutes.
- 5. If you have questions or problems, try to solve them on your own first. Look up unknown words in a dictionary, e.g. If you can't solve the problem on your own, ask your partner / neighbour for help. If he/she can't help you, put your name card on the "help list". Your teacher will come and help you then.
- 6. After 30 minutes stop working. Go to the teacher's desk and take a solution sheet. Compare your answers with the solution. Bring back the solution sheet to the teacher's desk. If you had an oral task or a creative task, present your findings during presentation time.
- 7. Put all clever lesson material into your folder and bring it back to the shelf at the end of the lesson.
